

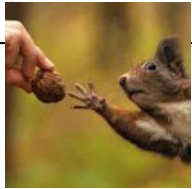

A number of times, I have heard members indicate that they are not receiving information from the club. Dave Skelton often sends out email blasts about a number of topics.

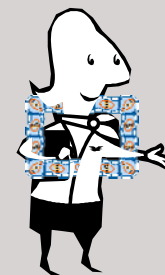
If you have moved locations and have not informed us, we have no way of knowing. As well, we need to let the OFAH know so that your magazine can reach you.

Again we will have an Early Bird Membership Renewal programme. The earlier you renew, the more chances you have to win a couple of worthwhile prizes. If you renew in December, you will get 2 free chances to win a prize, one of which is a free 2018 membership. The others are a cooler and a rod and reel. A Renewal Form is part of this newsletter. It is helpful if you complete the form and either send it or bring it when you renew. Something new for this year is the OFAH Paperless membership. In order to choose this option, you need a computer, internet access and probably a smart phone. This is not available to families of more than 2 persons.

Those who choose this option will get emails with the \$5,000,000 liability certificate that you can print if you choose. You will also receive a membership card that you can print. Finally, you will get the magazine in digital format. If you wish this option, you will need to let me know when you renew. We will need to verify your email address. Otherwise, I will assume that you want to continue as in the past. The paperless membership is a cost saving to the club and certainly less work for me.

The Quebec Ministry of Forests, Wildlife and Parks confirmed that the Asian carp, a fish that is destructive to the ecosystems in which it settles, has arrived in the St. Lawrence River.

Reminder: No ice is safe ice

The ice conditions on any lake can vary from location to location. Remember, even though it may look thick on the surface, moving water from streams, rivers and springs can cause ice to form unevenly.

People who do venture out on the ice should:

- Dress warmly in layers and consider wearing a life jacket or vest.
- Not go alone. Head out with friends or family. Take a cell phone and make sure someone knows where you are and when you are expected to return.
- Know before you go. Don't travel in areas you are not familiar and don't travel at night or during reduced visibility.
- Avoid inlets, outlets or narrows that may have current that can thin the ice.
- Look for clear ice, which is generally stronger than ice with snow on it or bubbles in it.
- Carry some basic safety gear: ice claws or picks, a cellphone in a waterproof bag or case, a life jacket and length of rope, and a spud bar to check ice while walking to new areas.
- Wear creepers attached to boots to prevent slipping on ice and take extra mittens or gloves so you always have a dry pair.

If you go through the ice:

- Carry a set of ice picks in your pocket to help you climb out of the ice hole.
- Once out of the water, do not stand up. Rather, walk on your forearms until the majority of your body is on solid surface.
- Try to remain calm, call for help and take steps to get out of the water as soon as possible.
