With winter getting ready to appear once again, work is underway to get the ranges ready for the winter season.

Sporting Clays is now done for 2025 and the equipment has been put away.

We are hoping to keep the Handgun, 22 Calibre Rimfire, 100-Yard and Lower Trap/Skeet fields open for the winter.

In order to accomplish this, we are looking for volunteers to assist with moving snow and keep the buildings free of snow buildup that can cause slip and trip hazards.

We are still looking for volunteers to blow snow on the 100 yard and Lower Trap/Skeet Field. If you are interested in learning how to run the Bobcat tractor please let us know and we will make arrangements to have someone help you.

All Trap/Skeet events are sanctioned events and are required to be on the "All Events Calendar". If you are planning on participating in these events, please check the "All Events Calendar" and if the weather is questionable contact the assigned RSO to see if the events have been cancelled or not. We are striving to do our best to keep the calendar updated, but sometimes weather changes rather quick, resulting in the event being cancelled.

Recently we have noticed an increase in spent shell casings not being picked up. Please remember that we are a volunteer organization and everyone is required to police their brass and pick them up. It should not be left to other members to do.

Looking back over the year, here are some pictures of the Youth Expo Event that occerred in early summer.




Frozen Holiday .22 Hunter Shoot Saturday, Dec. 6th 10:00 am

This .22 shoot is limited to scopes adjusted to 10x or less. SSA supplies CCI standared velocity. No high end rifles. No vudoos, anschutz or bergaras.

- 25 yds 5 shot at 5 matches \$5
- 50 yds spinner, 3 shots to swing the target one turn \$5
- 75 yds 3 shots to cut the wire \$5
- 100 yds 5 shot to hit all 5 targets \$5
