Thanks very much Ray.



## **SSA and OFAH Memberships**

Obviously, many of our members read the Email Blasts that I send out. Within 15 seconds, I was receiving membership renewals. I want to thank all of you who responded so quickly. All of the renewals have been processed and have been mailed. Again thank you.

The new OFAH Membership fee structure is not yet complete, but will probably be ready in early March. Until that time, you can renew with the 2024 OFAH rates. So what I am saying is that if you haven't renewed but plan to, you need to do it asap. You can renew on line or by using the form included in this newsletter or by calling me, John Ford, 226-664-0960 and using your credit card. It looks like the OFAH fee for Seniors and Adults will increase by \$20.00, However this will include a paper Ontario Out of Doors magazine if you choose. The family fee structure is less defined but the Primary Member will pay \$50 while the Spouse will pay an additional fee and children from 13 to 17 will also pay an additional fee. Children from 1 to 12 will be free. This will result in a substantial increase in OFAH costs and will have to be passed on to our members.

## 2024 Range Usage

All the Ranges were used 3292 times in 2024 by 474 members. This review does not include Range Rentals. There were 464 Guest using the ranges as well in 2024.

The breakdown is as follows:


When you look at the 2023 numbers, 384 members used the ranges 2844 times with 292 guests using the ranges.

2024 had an increase of 31.5% in the number of members who used the ranges in 2024, which resulted in a 15.7% increase in range usage by our members and 59% increase in guest usage. On review of the Guest Waivers, it was found that 22% were not completed correctly. When a SSA Members bring Guest to the ranges, the member is responsible to ensure that the Guest Waivers are completed properly.

Shotgun Range Safety Officer Course is in the process of being finalized we hope to run a course in the near future.

Please review the SSA "All Events Calendar" for any upcoming training and shooting events. The Range Committee would like to Thank all those members who volunteer their time to keep the ranges clean and functioning during this snow season.

On behalf of myself and the SSA Range Committee Members we look forward to seeing you in 2025.




### **SSA Wildlife Advisory Committee**


