

#### **SSA Club Awards**

Mike Thompson, Al Smith and I have been working on these hunting and fishing contests. We have made a start on having the rules and applications posted on our website. If you go to our website and click on the membership button, you will see them. https://www.sydenhamsportsmen.com/members/club-awards/ We also have paper applications at the club house bulletin board. One cardinal rule is that these entries must come from Grey or Bruce counties and must be harvested by current 2023 club members. First, we have the Big Fish awards. They include Chinook Salmon, Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout and Brook Trout. We have trophies for Adults, Students and Juniors in these categories. In each case, you complete an application form, which we have available on our website. You are required to measure the fork length and girth, take a photo on your phone and have a witness. Another category of the Awards programme is the Hard Luck award. 


# Youth Expo is being organized for 2023

**The Defensive Pistol** Action group begins their summer practice schedule on May 02 nd . They practice on the first and third Tuesday of every month for the summer, from 5:30 pm until sunset. If you are interested in trying this shooting discipline or have questions reach out to Jeff Caldwell at jrc870@gmail.com.

The first Interclub Trap event of 2023 will be finished by the time you read this newsletter. The second date will be hosted on May 13 th at the Blue Ridge Club ranges, and on Saturday May 27 th we will be hosting this social trap shooting event at our own ranges here at the SSA.

**Sporting Clays** gets started this month on both May 7 th and May 22 nd. Online registration only – follow the link on the All Events Calendar. Ammunition has been hard (and expensive!) to find this year – a reminder that we now have 20 ga. and 12 ga. ammunition for sale for these events. One of the benefits to being a member is access to affordable ammunition right here at your own club.

The Sporting clays course this year will use the main trap/skeet field as one of the stations for all of the sporting clays events – which means we should have some new and exciting targets to shoot at each time in the large window of "sky." If you are a trap-shooter any of these Sundays when Sporting Clays is open you will be shooting at the upper trap field on these days. Check the calendar!

#### Courses, Courses, and more training Courses.

Thank you to all the member volunteers who have stepped up in the last 2 years to participate in training courses to get members access to the different ranges at our club. This group of volunteers is growing again, and we have lots to update you on. In the past at the SSA there was an "exemption" process for new members who were trained in their professional duties to carry and use a firearm (typically a holstered handgun – police or security officer.)

As a club - we cannot provide an "exemption" to training – BUT - We have clarified what this training needs to look like are can tell you we are working on a "short course" format that would greatly streamline the process to get these professionals access to our handgun range. The Short Course will be focused on individuals who are currently carrying a holstered firearm in their professional duties and will certify you for using the handgun range with your holster all in one "short" course. Stay Tuned.

There will be a **Handgun Range Safety Course on May 14th**, registration is now open on the SSA website on the All Events Calendar.



# **Shooting Sports Committee and Range update (cont.)**

There will be a **Club Holster Course and a 100 yard range safety course** in June. Dates are still to be determined – keep an eye on the All Events Calendar.

If you are a new member and have not yet taken your SSA Orientation Course – remember that you need to take this course before using any of the Ranges. Reach out to Jay Murdoch if you still want to take this orientation.

**YOUTH EXPO DAY** at the SSA— On June 10 th the SSA will be co-hosting a youth expo day where we are hosting approximately 60 kids to experience events that will include .22 rimfire shooting on two of our ranges. We are looking for a few more volunteers to help some of these kids learn to shoot. You will be responsible for supervising one .22 rifle (your own or one of the club youth rifles) on one lane only.

Good camaraderie and lunch provided. Reach out to Jay if you are interested in helping with this. To finish – (yes) this sounds like a broken record – but its TRUE that everything that happens at this club gets done by volunteers.
